Social Psychiatric Worker

Job Tasks:

- The Social Psychiatric Worker is responsible for the assessment, care planning, execution, and monitoring of individualized care for clients and client groups with less complex needs.
- The role combines direct care, psycho-education, crisis intervention, and coordination with the multidisciplinary team to improve the client's quality of life.
- This function is specifically geared towards psychiatric clients with low psychological symptom severity and clients with low academic functioning.
- Demonstrates tact, empathy, and self-confidence when guiding clients in care and rehabilitation.
- Must maintain accurate documentation and follow transport and safety procedures consistently.
- Additionally, the role requires an understanding of multi-cultural issues and how these factors influence treatment approaches, ensuring culturally sensitive care to clients.

Qualifications:

- MBO 3 level education in Social Pedagogic Worker is minimally required for this position along with several years of experience working within a Mental Health Facility.
- Preferred is a MBO 4 degree in Social Pedagogic Worker with several years of experience within a Mental Health Facility.
- Knowledgeable in legislation related to mental health care, as well as the issuance of relevant rules, guidelines and protocols within the field.
- Must be in possession of a valid B-Driver's license.
