- Conducts comprehensive assessments of patients and their environments to inform the intake process, identify needs and guides the formulation of a personalized nurse treatment plan.
- Combines clinical insight with strong case management skills.
- Is skilled in crisis intervention, care coordination and therapeutic communication.
- Must be available to be scheduled to work 24-hour on-call shifts.
- Works independently within a multidisciplinary team.
- Contributes to high-quality and efficient care delivery to clients with attention to productivity being monitored.
- Assesses the situation in the event of an actual or impending crisis and intervenes accordingly.

- **Registered Nurse (MBO-4+/Bachelor) or Social Psychiatric Nurse (SPV).**
- Experience in mental health care (ambulant/outpatient care preferred).
